

10-Day Safari & Wildlife Expedition

A comprehensive ten-day safari across three different game reserves with internal flights, varied accommodation (luxury lodge, tented camp, mobile camp), morning and afternoon game drives, bush walks, boat safaris, and a cultural village visit.

Day 1 — Arrival at Reserve A

Charter Flight to Reserve A

Transport

Description:	Light aircraft from the regional hub to Reserve A bush airstrip. Soft bags only, 15 kg limit. Aerial views of the savanna during approach.

Accommodation

Description:	Premium lodge overlooking a waterhole. Spacious suites, private verandas, pool, spa. Full board with house wines and local beers. The waterhole attracts animals day and night.

Safari Introduction & Safety

Info

Description:	Head ranger safety briefing. Vehicle rules, camp behavior after dark, malaria prevention. Sign the indemnity form. Collect binoculars and wildlife guide from the lodge library.
Group Size:	Max 6 guests per vehicle, 2 vehicles
Fitness Requirement:	Light — two walking safaris on uneven ground

Afternoon Game Drive — Introduction

 Easy

Activity

Description:	First game drive at 15:30. Orientation to the reserve — vegetation zones, animal territories, and driving routes. Plains game and birds dominate the first afternoon.
Duration:	3h 0min

Welcome Dinner

Meal

Description:	Dinner in the boma with introductions all round. The guides join the table on the first night — it is the easiest moment to tell them what you most want to see, which shapes where the vehicles go for the next three days.

Day 2 — Reserve A: Full Day

Sunrise Game Drive Easy Activity

Description:	Pre-dawn departure. Predators most active at dawn — lions, leopards, cheetahs. Dress in warm layers for the open vehicle.

Bush Breakfast Meal

Description:	Full breakfast cooked in the bush at a scenic spot. An iconic safari experience.
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Midday Rest Free Time

Description:	Return to lodge. Pool, waterhole watching, or siesta. Wildlife rests midday too.

Afternoon Drive & Sundowner Easy Activity

Description:	Explore different terrain. Sundowner drinks at a hilltop viewpoint as the sun sets.

Day 3 — Reserve A: Bush Walk & Night Drive

Guided Bush Walk Moderate Activity

Description:	On-foot safari with armed guide. Tracks, dung, plants, and insects — a completely different perspective. Max 8 people for safety.

Walking Safari Protocol Info

Description:	Single file behind guide. Whisper only. Neutral colors. No perfume. If charged by an elephant — stand your ground and follow the guide. If separated — stay put.

Description: Rest before tonight's night drive. Last afternoon at this lodge.
Duration: 3h 0min

Night Game Drive

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Activity

Description: After-dark drive with spotlight. Eyeshine reveals nocturnal species: owls, bushbabies, genets, porcupines, hunting hyenas.
Duration: 3h 0min

Spotlight Protocol

Info

Description: Red filter on spotlight for predators (less disturbance). Keep beam moving. No flash photography. Maintain 30 m from all animals at night. Engine off for sightings — whisper only.

Late Dinner

Meal

Description: Late dinner once the vehicles are back in. The kitchen holds service until the night drive returns, so eat when you arrive rather than waiting for the group.
Start Time: 21:30

Day 4 — Flight to Reserve B

Internal Flight to Reserve B

Transport

Description: Morning flight from Reserve A airstrip to Reserve B. Different ecosystem — riverine woodland and floodplains. New species to find.
Duration: 1h 0min

Charter Flight Details

Info

Description: 15 kg soft bag limit strictly enforced. Check in at airstrip 30 min before departure. Excess luggage stored at Reserve A lodge (collected on return). Bring camera and binoculars in hand luggage — the flight over the delta is spectacular.

Tented Camp — Reserve B

Accommodation

Description: Luxury tented camp on the river. Canvas walls, wooden deck, en-suite with hot water. 8 tents — intimate and close to nature. Full board included.

Description:	First drive in Reserve B. Different landscape, different species. The guide knows this terrain intimately.

Description:	Dinner by lantern light at the river camp. Hippo grunts from the water.
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Day 5 — Reserve B: Water & Land

Morning Game Drive ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Dawn drive focusing on the floodplain edge where predators hunt in the morning mist.
Duration:	4h 0min

Boat Safari ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Afternoon boat safari on the river. Hippos, crocodiles, fish eagles, and kingfishers. A completely different viewing angle from the water.

Description:	Drinks and snacks on a river sandbank as the sun sets. Wildlife continues past you in the golden light.

Description:	Dinner at camp under canvas. Confirm the morning arrangements over dinner: the fishing runs alongside the morning drive rather than after it, so the group splits at breakfast.
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Day 6 — Reserve B: Relaxed Day

Morning Drive ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Morning drive targeting species specific to this reserve's ecosystem.
Duration:	3h 0min

Optional: Fishing ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Catch-and-release fishing on the river. Tigerfish and bream. Guide supervises. Even non-anglers enjoy the riverbank at this time.

Description:	Quiet afternoon at camp. Read, photograph birds from the deck, or have a spa treatment.

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Day 7 — Transfer to Reserve C

Overland Transfer to Reserve C Transport

Description:	Game-drive style transfer between reserves. The guide stops for sightings throughout the 3-hour drive.

Description:	Stop at a traditional village en route. Meet community elders, see traditional crafts, understand the relationship between people and wildlife. A respectful, enriching cultural exchange.

Description:	Mobile tented camp — the most remote accommodation of the trip. Canvas tents, bucket showers, and paraffin lanterns. Closest to the wild experience possible with comfort. No electricity — embrace it.

Description:	First drive in Reserve C. More remote, wilder, fewer vehicles. Different vegetation and potentially different species.

Day 8 — Reserve C: Intensive Safari

Dawn Game Drive

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Activity

Description: Extended dawn drive in the remote area. The guide pursues specific sightings — the elusive species on the group's wish list.

Duration: 5h 0min

Meal

Description: Late brunch in the bush. The drive doesn't return to camp — eat where the wildlife takes you.

Description: Afternoon rest at camp. Journal, photograph camp birds, listen to the bush.

Activity

Description: Walking safari from the mobile camp. More adventurous than the lodge walk — deeper bush, no follow vehicle.

Meal

Description: Campfire dinner on the second-to-last night. The mobile camp cooks over open fire and serves one set menu — dietary requirements need to reach the camp manager by lunchtime, not at the table.

Day 9 — Reserve C: Conservation Day

Description: Final morning drive. The guide focuses on photography opportunities and any species not yet seen.

Duration: 4h 0min

Conservation Talk

Info

Description: The reserve's conservation manager gives a talk on wildlife protection, anti-poaching efforts, community partnerships, and how tourism supports conservation. Learn what your visit contributes to the ecosystem.

Sunset Drive

Activity

Description: Final game drive. The guide takes you to the reserve's best sundowner spot. A toast to the wildlife, the guides, and the African bush.

Farewell Bush Dinner

Meal

Description: Final dinner at the mobile camp. Star-lit, fire-warmed, wild. The last night of the safari.

Wildlife Checklist Review

Info

Description: Compile the final species list with the guide. Big five status, total species count, and any rare sightings. The guide signs the checklist as a keepsake.

Day 10 — Departure

Final Sunrise Drive

Activity

Description: Last game drive. Short but sweet. The guide aims for one final special sighting to close the safari.

Meal

Description: Brunch at camp. Sign the guest book. Say goodbye to the camp team — personal connections with camp staff are part of the safari magic.

Transfer to Airstrip

Description: Drive to the airstrip for the return flight. Keep cameras ready — the drive often produces surprise sightings.

Duration: 1h 30min

Transport

Description: Flight back to the regional hub. Aerial farewell to the reserves. Connect to international flight or continue to next destination.

Safari Summary

Info

Description: Ten-day safari complete: 3 reserves, 15 game drives, 2 bush walks, 1 boat safari, 1 night drive, 1 cultural visit. Share photos via the group album.

What's Included

Info

Description: Charter flights in and out plus the internal flight to Reserve B, the overland crossing to Reserve C, nine nights across a lodge, a tented camp and a mobile camp, all meals from the day-one dinner to the day-ten brunch, and the cultural village visit. Guided activities are priced individually above so a base rate can be quoted and built on, which is how most guests buy a trip of this length.

What's Not Included

Info

Description: Conservation and park fees for all three reserves, charged per person per day and collected at each gate in cash — the three rates differ and together they are the largest excluded cost on this itinerary, so budget 60–120 EUR per day and confirm each before travel. Also excluded: international flights, drinks beyond tea and coffee, travel and medical insurance, laundry, curios, and gratuities for guides, trackers and camp staff.

Insurance & Documents

Info

Description: Travel and medical insurance with emergency air evacuation is mandatory, and on this itinerary it is not a formality: the mobile camp in Reserve C is a full day from a road and evacuation is by air only. The policy must also cover walking safari, which several insurers class as an adventure activity and exclude by default. Bring a passport valid six months beyond departure with four blank pages for three reserve entries, printed visa confirmation, and a yellow-fever certificate if your routing requires it.
