

3-Day Wildlife Safari

A classic three-day safari experience with morning and afternoon game drives, a bush breakfast, and comfortable lodge accommodation. Covers wildlife viewing strategy, safety protocols, and practical tips for maximizing sightings.

Day 1 — Arrival & Afternoon Game Drive

Airport Transfer to Lodge

Transport

Description:	Private transfer from the airstrip or regional airport to the safari lodge. The drive passes through increasingly wild terrain — keep eyes open, wildlife sightings are possible even on the access road.
Duration:	1h 30min
Price:	50 €

Safari Lodge Check-in

Accommodation

Description:	Comfortable lodge on the edge of the reserve, booked for two nights. Rooms have mosquito nets, en-suite bathrooms and a veranda overlooking the bush. The rate is per person per night on full board — all meals, tea and coffee — with game drives charged separately as listed. Keep room doors closed: the resident vervet monkeys open unlatched ones.

Safari Safety Briefing

Info

Description:	Mandatory safety briefing by the head ranger. Covers vehicle rules (stay seated, no standing, arms inside), approach distances for different animals, what to do during close encounters, and camp behavior after dark. Photography flash is prohibited near animals.
Group Size:	Max 6 guests per vehicle, window seat each
Fitness Requirement:	None — vehicle-based, some early starts

Afternoon Game Drive

 Easy

Activity

Description:	First game drive departing mid-afternoon when animals become active after the midday heat. Open-sided 4x4 with an experienced tracker. Focus areas include waterholes and grazing plains. Expect herds of herbivores and their predators positioning for the evening hunt.
Duration:	3h 0min

Dinner at Lodge

Meal

Description:	Three-course dinner at the lodge restaurant or outdoor boma. Includes local and international dishes. Share the day's sightings with fellow guests — the communal table tradition is part of the safari experience.

Day 2 — Full Day in the Bush

Sunrise Game Drive Easy Activity

Description:	Early departure for the best wildlife viewing of the trip. Dawn is when predators are most active — lions returning from night hunts, cheetahs scanning for prey in the low light. Dress in layers, it can be surprisingly cold on an open vehicle before sunrise.
Duration:	4h 0min

Wildlife Viewing Tips Info

Description:	Dawn light is ideal for photography — golden tones, active animals, low contrast. Keep cameras ready at all times. Watch for alarm calls from birds and small mammals — they often signal a predator nearby. Binoculars are essential for identifying distant animals. Stay quiet during approaches.
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Bush Breakfast Meal

Description:	Breakfast served in the bush at a scenic spot chosen by the guide. Full English-style breakfast cooked over a portable stove, plus fresh fruit and coffee. A unique experience — eating outdoors with the sounds of the wild around you.
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Midday Rest at Lodge Free Time

Description:	Return to lodge for the hottest hours. Wildlife rests in the shade during midday, so this is the natural break. Swim in the pool, nap, read, or sit on your veranda with binoculars — animals sometimes come to the lodge waterhole.
Duration:	3h 0min

Afternoon Game Drive & Sundowner Easy Activity

Description:	Second game drive focusing on different terrain — riverine bush, kopjes, or woodland. The drive includes a sundowner stop — drinks and snacks at a scenic overlook as the sun sets. Watch for nocturnal animals becoming active as dusk approaches.
Duration:	3h 30min
Start Time:	15:00

Dinner Under the Stars Meal

Description:	Special outdoor dinner under the African sky. The lodge sets up lantern-lit tables in the boma enclosure. Listen for hyena calls and the distant rumble of lions while dining. A memorable end to the best day of the safari.
Start Time:	20:00

Day 3 — Morning Drive & Departure

Final Morning Game Drive ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Last chance for wildlife sightings. The guide will focus on any animals not yet seen — if the big cats have been elusive, this is the morning to find them. A shorter drive to allow time for checkout, but equally productive.
Duration:	3h 0min
Start Time:	06:00

Brunch at Lodge Meal

Description:	Late brunch back at the lodge after the drive. Full buffet spread. Last chance to enjoy the lodge facilities and settle any extras at reception.
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Lodge Check-out Accommodation

Description:	Check out of the lodge. Confirm no outstanding charges. Tip the guide and lodge staff — customary and appreciated.
Check-out:	Invalid Date

Transfer to Airport Transport

Description:	Transfer back to the airstrip or regional airport for onward travel. Allow extra time — roads in reserves are unpaved and slow. Wildlife on the road can cause delays (the best kind of delay).
Duration:	1h 30min

Safari Summary Info

Description:	Review sighting log — record which species were spotted, highlight any special encounters. Collect tip recommendations from the lodge for future guests. Check that all camera memory cards and footage are backed up before departure.
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What's Included Info

Description:	Return airstrip transfers, two nights at the lodge on full board, four game drives with a professional guide and tracker in an open 4x4 with a guaranteed window seat, the bush breakfast and the sundowner stop, and use of the lodge binoculars and reference books.
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What's Not Included Info

Description:	Conservation and park fees, which are levied per person per day by the reserve and collected at the gate — budget 60–90 EUR per day depending on the reserve and the season, and expect it to be cash. Also excluded: international and domestic flights, drinks other than tea and coffee, travel and medical insurance, laundry, curio purchases, and gratuities for the guide, tracker and lodge staff.
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Insurance & Documents Info

Description:

Travel and medical insurance including emergency evacuation is mandatory — the nearest hospital is hours away by road and evacuation from a reserve is by air. Bring a passport valid six months beyond departure with two blank pages, your visa or e-visa confirmation printed, and a yellow-fever certificate if you are arriving from or transiting a country where it is required. Check malaria prophylaxis with your doctor at least two weeks before travel.
