

5-Day Safari Adventure

An immersive five-day safari with morning and afternoon game drives, guided bush walks, a night drive, and a camp transfer to explore different ecosystems. Mix of luxury lodge and tented camp accommodation with full-board catering.

Day 1 — Arrival at Safari Lodge

Charter Flight to Airstrip

Transport

Description:	Light aircraft transfer from the regional hub to the bush airstrip. Maximum baggage 15 kg in soft bags only — no hard suitcases. The 45-minute flight offers aerial views of the landscape and sometimes wildlife visible from the air.

Main Safari Lodge

Accommodation

Description:	Luxury safari lodge overlooking a waterhole. Spacious rooms with private verandas, en-suite bathrooms, ceiling fans, and mosquito nets. Full board — all meals, house wines, local beers, teas, and coffees included. The lodge has a swimming pool, curio shop, and a reference library with wildlife books.

Safari Briefing

Info

Description:	Mandatory safety briefing by the head ranger. Topics: vehicle behavior (stay seated, arms inside, no flash photography), walking rules in camp (escort after dark, no food in rooms), malaria prevention (repellent, long sleeves at dusk, prophylaxis), and emergency procedures. Sign the indemnity form.
Group Size:	Max 6 guests per vehicle, 2 vehicles
Fitness Requirement:	Light — one 3 h bush walk on uneven ground

Afternoon Game Drive — Introductory

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Activity

Description:	First game drive departing at 15:30 when the afternoon heat subsides and animals become active. Open-sided 4x4 with a professional guide and tracker. Today focuses on orientation — understanding the reserve's geography, vegetation zones, and animal territories. Expect plains game, birds, and possibly the first predator sighting.

Welcome Dinner Under Stars

Meal

Description:	Outdoor dinner in the lodge's boma — a traditional circular enclosure lit by lanterns and a central fire. Multi-course meal featuring local and international cuisine. Meet the lodge manager and head guide. Share first impressions and set expectations for the days ahead.

Day 2 — Full Day Game Drives

Early Morning Game Drive ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Pre-dawn departure for the best wildlife viewing. Dawn is when predators are most active — lions, leopards, and cheetahs hunt in the cool morning hours. Dress in warm layers (it's cold on an open vehicle), bring binoculars, and keep cameras ready. Coffee and rusks served before departure.

Wildlife Photography Tips Info

Description:	Best settings for dawn light: ISO 800-1600, aperture f/5.6 or wider, shutter speed 1/500 minimum for moving animals. Use burst mode sparingly (noise disturbs wildlife). A bean-bag on the vehicle rail stabilizes long lenses. The golden hour after sunrise produces the warmest light. Avoid photographing directly into the sun — reposition the vehicle if possible.
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Bush Breakfast Meal

Description:	Full breakfast served in the bush at a scenic spot chosen by the guide — under a tree, beside a river, or overlooking a plain. Cooked breakfast with eggs, bacon, toast, fresh fruit, and excellent coffee. An unforgettable dining experience with the wild as your backdrop.
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Midday Rest at Lodge Free Time

Description:	Return to the lodge during the hottest hours (11:00-15:00). Wildlife rests in the shade during midday, so this is the natural break. Swim in the pool, read on your veranda, or watch the waterhole — animals visit throughout the day. The resident warthogs and monkeys provide constant entertainment.

Afternoon Game Drive with Sundowner ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Second drive of the day exploring different terrain — dense bush, riverine forest, or rocky outcrops. The guide focuses on species not yet seen. The drive includes a sundowner stop — gin and tonics on a hilltop as the sun sets over the bush. Watch for nocturnal animals emerging in the twilight.

Dinner at Lodge Meal

Description:	Dinner at the main lodge restaurant. Four-course menu changes nightly. Share the day's sighting highlights with fellow guests — the communal table tradition makes every evening social. Check the sighting board in the lobby for what others saw today.

Day 3 — Bush Walk & Night Drive

Guided Bush Walk ●●●● Moderate Activity

Description:	On-foot safari with an armed guide and tracker. Walking through the bush gives a completely different perspective — you notice insects, tracks, dung, and plant life that you miss from a vehicle. The guide teaches tracking skills, plant identification, and animal behavior reading. Maximum group of 8 for safety.

Walking Safari Safety Info

Description:	Walk in single file behind the guide. No talking above a whisper. Wear neutral colors (khaki, olive, brown). No bright colors, perfume, or aftershave. If the guide signals to stop, freeze immediately. If charged by an elephant, do NOT run — stand your ground and follow the guide's instruction. In case of separation, stay where you are.
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Lodge Lunch Meal

Description:	Lunch at the lodge. Buffet-style with salads, cold meats, hot dishes, and desserts. Eat well — the evening has a night drive planned. Drink plenty of water in the heat.
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Afternoon Rest Free Time

Description:	Relaxed afternoon at the lodge. Visit the curio shop, have a spa treatment (book in advance), or sit on the waterhole deck with binoculars. This is your last afternoon at this lodge — make the most of the setting.
Duration:	3h 0min

Night Game Drive with Spotlight ●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	A completely different safari experience — searching for nocturnal animals with a hand-held spotlight. Look for eyeshine in the bush: red eyes = nightjars, green = predators, orange = herbivores. Common sightings: owls, bushbabies, genets, porcupines, and with luck, a hunting leopard or lion pride on the move.

Boma Dinner Meal

Description:	Special dinner at the outdoor boma with a roaring fire and traditional music. Grilled meats, stews, and local dishes cooked over coals. A cultural experience as much as a culinary one. Star-filled sky overhead.

Day 4 — Camp Transfer & New Territory

Drive to Tented Camp Transport

Description:	Transfer from the main lodge to a more remote tented camp in a different ecosystem — riverine woodland, savanna plains, or marshland. The 3-hour drive is itself a game drive — the guide stops for sightings along the way. Different terrain means different species.

Luxury Tented Camp Accommodation

Description:	Canvas-walled luxury tents on raised wooden platforms. En-suite bathroom with hot water (solar heated), comfortable beds with high-quality linens, and a private deck overlooking the river. More intimate than the lodge — only 8 tents, closer to nature. Full board included.

Lunch at Camp Meal

Description:	Welcome lunch at the camp's open-air dining area. Lighter fare suited to the heat — fresh salads, grilled fish, tropical fruits. The camp manager introduces the area and what species to expect here.
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Afternoon Game Drive — New Territory ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	First game drive from the new camp. The terrain and species mix differs from the lodge area. The guide knows this area intimately and will target specific animals and viewing spots. Pay attention to how the landscape changes — different soil, different plants, different animals.

Optional: River Fishing ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	For those interested, catch-and-release fishing on the river with the camp's equipment. The guide supervises and assists. Tigerfish and bream are the main targets. Even if you don't fish, the riverbank at sunset is a beautiful spot.

Campfire Dinner Meal

Description:	Dinner around the campfire. The camp chef prepares a multi-course meal with a mix of bush cooking and fine dining. Hippo grunts and hyena calls provide the soundtrack. Close to nature in every sense.

Day 5 — Final Drive & Departure

Sunrise Game Drive ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Final game drive — the guide will aim for any species on your wish list not yet seen. The early morning light at this camp is exceptional for photography. Savor the last hours in the bush. The guide shares a summary of all species spotted during the trip.

Farewell Brunch Meal

Description:	Brunch at the camp after the final drive. Full spread with hot and cold dishes. Last chance to enjoy the camp's setting before departure. Sign the guest book and leave a note for future visitors.
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Camp Check-out Accommodation

Description:	Check out of the camp. Settle any extras — bar, laundry, shop. Tip the guide, tracker, camp staff, and room attendant. Tips are customary and form a significant part of staff income. The camp manager will advise on appropriate amounts.

Transfer to Airstrip Transport

Description:	Transfer to the bush airstrip for the return flight. Keep cameras accessible — the drive to the airstrip often produces surprise sightings. Last chance to spot that elusive animal.

Safari Summary & Feedback Info

Description:	Safari complete — 5 days, 8 game drives, 1 bush walk, 1 night drive. Compile the wildlife checklist: big five, other mammals, birds, reptiles. The guide will share the final count and highlight any rare sightings. Share photos via the group album.
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What's Included Info

Description:	Charter flight in and road transfer out, three nights at the main lodge and one at the tented camp, all meals from the day-one dinner to the day-five brunch, and the inter-camp transfer. Game drives, the bush walk, the night drive and the fishing are priced individually above so you can quote a base rate and let the client build on it — which is how most guests prefer to buy a five-day safari.
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What's Not Included Info

Description:	Conservation and park fees, charged per person per day by each reserve and collected at the gate in cash — this trip crosses two reserves with different rates, so budget 60–90 EUR per day and check both. Also excluded: international flights, drinks beyond tea and coffee, travel and medical insurance, laundry at the camp, and gratuities for guides, trackers and camp staff.
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Insurance & Documents Info

Description:

Travel and medical insurance with emergency air evacuation is mandatory — the tented camp is two hours from the nearest airstrip and evacuation is by air, not road. The policy must cover the guided bush walk, which some insurers class as an adventure activity. Bring a passport valid six months beyond departure with two blank pages, printed visa confirmation, and a yellow-fever certificate if your routing requires it. Discuss malaria prophylaxis with your doctor at least two weeks out.
