

City Walking Tour

A full-day guided walking tour through a city's most interesting districts. Covers historical landmarks, a museum visit, markets, and local cuisine. Flexible pace with free time for independent exploration.

Day 1 — City Walking Tour

Tour Overview Info

Description:	Full-day walking tour covering approximately 8 km across the city's main districts. Comfortable shoes essential — the route includes cobblestones, stairs, and some hilly sections. Divided into morning (historical center), midday (museum), and afternoon (art district or waterfront). Total walking time 4-5 hours with frequent stops.
Group Size:	2-15 people, 1 licensed guide
Fitness Requirement:	Light — 8 km on foot, cobbles and stairs

Old Town Exploration ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Walking tour through the historic old town. Visit the main square, cathedral or principal church, town hall, and surrounding medieval streets. The guide provides historical context and points out architectural details that most visitors miss. Allow time for photos at the key viewpoints.

Museum or Gallery Visit ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Visit the city's flagship museum or gallery. Focus on the highlights rather than trying to see everything — the guide will lead you through the most significant collections. Audio guides available in multiple languages at most venues. Skip-the-line tickets recommended in high season.

Exhibition Highlights Info

Description:	Focus on the permanent collection's strongest sections. Check the museum website for current temporary exhibitions — these often require separate tickets and timed entry. The museum shop has high-quality postcards and art prints. Photography policies vary — some galleries allow no-flash photography, others prohibit cameras entirely.
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Local Cuisine Lunch Meal

Description:	Lunch at a restaurant known for authentic local cuisine. Order a set menu or ask the guide for recommendations — they know which dishes are genuine local specialties versus tourist-oriented versions. A glass of regional wine or beer completes the experience.

Afternoon District Walk ●●●●● Easy Activity

Description:	Explore the city's creative or waterfront district. Street art, independent shops, and local cafés give a different feel from the historic center. The guide shares stories about the neighborhood's transformation and points out hidden courtyards and rooftop viewpoints.
Duration:	2h 0min
Distance:	3.0 km

Independent Exploration Free Time

Description:	Free time for shopping, revisiting a favorite spot, or simply sitting at a café and watching city life. The guide can recommend specific shops, viewpoints, or quieter streets based on individual interests.
Duration:	1h 0min

Optional Farewell Dinner Meal

Description:	Optional group dinner at a carefully chosen restaurant. Reservations recommended — popular spots fill up quickly, especially on weekends. A relaxed end to the day to share impressions and favorite discoveries.

Return to Accommodation Transport

Description:	Walk, taxi, or public transport back to accommodation. The guide can help with directions and transit tickets. Evening walks through illuminated streets offer a completely different perspective of the city.

What's Included Info

Description:	A licensed local guide for the full day, museum entry with skip-the-line tickets booked ahead, lunch at a restaurant chosen for local cooking rather than proximity to the sights, and a route planned around the district rather than the postcard list.
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What's Not Included Info

Description:	Hotel and travel to the city, breakfast and dinner, drinks beyond those with lunch, entry to any temporary exhibition — these carry separate timed tickets — public transport if the group chooses to ride rather than walk a section, and gratuities.
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Insurance & Documents Info

Description:	No documents are needed beyond photo ID for museum concessions if you are claiming a student or senior rate — bring proof, since it is asked for. Ordinary travel insurance is sufficient; there is nothing here an insurer would call an activity. Comfortable shoes are not a document but they are the one thing that ruins this day.
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
